- <u>Sundbyholms slott/Sundbyholm Castle:</u> Sundbyholm Castle built by Carl Carlsson (Gyllenhielm), son of Duke Charles (later King Charles IX). He also founded an ironworks and two glassworks and Sweden's first elementary school at Sundby church. Today Sundbyholm is a wonderful setting for conferences, corporate parties, good dinners and romantic castle wedding.

- <u>Retuna Återbruksgalleria/Retuna Recycling Galleria, including coffee</u>
 <u>break:</u>

Retuna Recycling Galleria is Sweden's, and perhaps the world's first shopping mall that will take advantage of things that need new homes. The renovation, repair and creative reuse may give things new life and can be resold. Retuna calls it recycling - a climate friendly way of doing business.

• <u>STIGA Sports Arena and Munktellbadet/The Munktell Bath:</u> STIGA Sports Arena Eskilstuna is a modern eco building for sports, concerts and exhibitions. Next to the arena, the Munktell Bath is situated, which is a very modern bathhouse with indoor swimming pool, family spa, wellness and fitness centre and cafés.
